ON THE GREENCOURSE SUPERINTENDENT Brandon Perrine

With spring in the air and temperatures rising the turf is finally starting to break winter dormancy. Our golf course maintenance team has been hard at work getting the course in shape for the 2017 golf season. Our first big projects are well underway on the course and around the clubhouse. Ground surrounding the two Deerwood Country Club signs along the Woodlane Road entrance have been cleaned up and the low lying junipers have been removed and will be replaced with colorful plantings of annual flowers. Around the course, we have put out all the course accessories including: bunker rakes, new flag sticks, new flags, new cups, tee markers, trash cans, hole and yardage signs, ball washers, divot buckets and water coolers. The maintenance team is currently in the process of edging and re-flashing all the green side bunkers, and plan on doing the same on all fairway bunkers once finished with greensides. We have also mowed off the winter desiccation on all the playing surfaces. We have already finished our spring core aerification on tee boxes and solid tinning aerification on fairways. Our spring aerification on greens will take place Monday and Tuesday, April 10 & 11.

There are a lot of new faces in the maintenance department, so please stop us and say hi if you have a chance. We look forward to interacting with all the members, and look forward to producing high level playing conditions on the course that everyone will enjoy!
