We have been fortunate this winter not to have snow and frozen tundra. Because of the mild temps the majority of members have been able to practice and play. Opening Day 2017 is scheduled for Saturday April 1st. Breakfast will begin 8:00am. Shotgun start 9:00am, lunch to follow. Please sign up in the pro shop. The format will be an A, B, C, D, scramble.

**USGA, R&A propose sweeping overhaul of golf rules for 2019:** Please take the time to review proposed rule changes for 2019. My favorites: leaving flagstick in the hole while putting. Tapping down almost all damage to putting green. Elimination of penalties for accidental touching of loose impediments in bunkers and penalty areas. You will be able to drop a ball from any distance above the ground. In 2016 the USGA's two biggest championships ended in turmoil because of rulings that were widely criticized. Suggested changes reflect an embrace of modernity.

You may have noticed lately that there has been a tremendous increase in popularity or at least visibility of Rosé in the wine and beverage landscape. As spring approaches you can count on this phenomena growing more and more. In the coming weeks we will be working with our best suppliers, (and I mean working...hey tasting wine is a tough job but somebody has to do it), to acquire a few tasty Rosés for our wine list. This current surge in the availability and variety of Rosé is accompanied by an increase in quality within this wine segment. It certainly is a far cry from the days of Lancers, Mateus, Riunite and more recently (although not that recent), White Zinfandel. As with all wine, Rosé receives its color from the grape skins. The longer the skins remain in contact with the juice the darker the pink hue the wine is left with. The dryness or sweetness of the wine is mostly attributed to the variety of grapes used. And most Rosé wines are made from a variety of grapes. France remains the largest producer of Rosé followed by Spain, Italy and California. We have listed for some time now one of the great bottlings of this versatile wine. Caves D’Esclans Whispering Angel is a delicious, dryer style Rosé from Provence, France, arguably the best region in the world for Rosé production. You can start with this one, and as we discover a few more pink gems, you will be the first to know. Cheers!

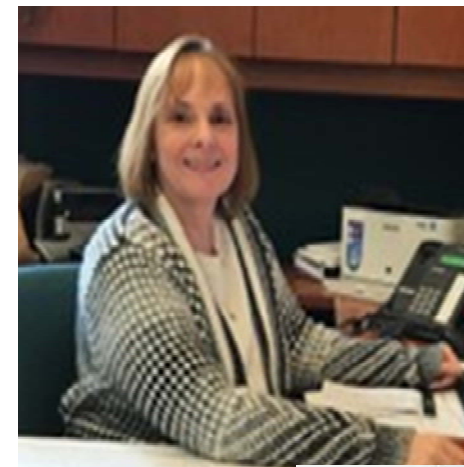
